Membership dues are typically paid before the Spring/Summer season begins. MAPA dues can now be paid online via www.PayPal.com. Using PayPal, send money to Mid-Atlantic Paddlers Assoc. via email address: Canoe_Dude@cox.net. Use the "Send money to friends or family" option, enter the Dues amount, and then enter the membership type you desire in the "Add a note" block. NOT to check the box for "Paying for Goods or Services". There is a small fee for using your credit card.
